INTRODUCTION

Morgenstadt: City Insights

The Fraunhofer-Gesellschaft had discerned the role of cities as drivers of ecological, social and economic innovation years ago. Then, in 2011, Fraunhofer experts from various fields joined forces to support cities in their quest for more innovation. Eleven Fraunhofer Institutes are joined by another 36 partners from cities, municipalities and industry to pool together their skill-sets in a joint project called Morgenstadt: City Insights (m:ci). This initiative underpins cities' efforts toward sustainable urban development in several ways.

Our mission at Morgenstadt is to future-proof cities. We see urban communities as complex adaptive systems, and are working with municipal governments, businesses and research institutes to define local paths to innovation and urban development. Tying together technological innovation, urban development, and the social and ecological prerequisites for sustainable and integrative urban communities, Morgenstadt is helping to create cities that are ready for the future.

Why "The Future of Public Space"?

The advance of innovative information and communication technologies has a momentous impact on our daily lives, and it is changing public space around the world. Mobility-on-demand systems and autonomous vehicles have entered the start-up phase and will soon facilitate transportation in congested inner cities.

Once these systems are in place, parking spaces may be converted to other uses, creating new public space for people. Entitled "The Future of Public Space", the upcoming Morgenstadt Conference intends to examine the impact of such systems on urban development and the lives of city dwellers.

These major changes will certainly transform urban mobility, but utilities such as water and energy will also have to adapt and improve for tomorrow's cities. All these changes require new forms of governance that factor urbanites' needs into the equation and afford the public more opportunities for participation. And finally, advancing digitalization is going to put its stamp on the communication channels in tomorrow's public space.

In many cases, these transformations tie in with the development of innovative technologies and evolving municipal management practices. With companies seeking to change these spaces to commercial ends, citizen-activists are putting up stiffer resistance to the trend toward privatization. With all this in mind, the Morgenstadt Conference seeks to answer the questions of how these interrelated processes will shape city dwellers' habits and, conversely, how city dwellers will be afforded the opportunity to actively shape these processes.
